### Bachelor of Arts in Public Management, Leadership and Policy

The Bachelor of Arts degree in Public Management, Leadership and Policy is designed to develop your skills in the areas of management, leadership and policy analysis, while providing additional training in data analysis, economics and public finance. ### Bachelor of Science in Public Policy Analysis

The Bachelor of Science degree in Public Policy Analysis is not a common degree at most colleges; it is designed to give students who want to work in policy or data analysis an edge. The curriculum provides extensive training in policy analysis, public finance, budgeting and economics. If you want to use data to solve problems and help change the world, the Bachelor of Science is for you.

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### Combined Undergraduate and Graduate Degree Programs

Students are able to earn a Glenn College undergraduate degree (BA or BS) and a Master of Public Administration (MPA) degree in only five years. Students in the program take undergraduate coursework during their first three years, enroll in a combination of undergraduate and graduate classes in year four, and complete the remaining MPA requirements in year five.

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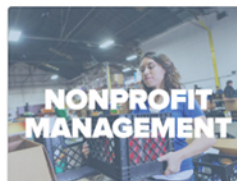
## MINORS



### Civic Engagement

The Civic Engagement Minor allows students to examine how a person can become an engaged, active member of their community and participate in a democratic society. Students take classes focusing on political and community engagement, plus an experiential learning requirement which can be fulfilled through an internship or service learning course.

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### Nonprofit Management

The Nonprofit Management minor introduces students to the unique opportunities and challenges of the nonprofit world. Students will take courses from multiple departments on campus and can pursue an internship with a nonprofit organization in order to gain a better understanding of the role nonprofits play in serving the public.

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### Public Policy

Public policy refers to the actions taken by government to solve public problems, and their resulting impacts. This minor introduces students to the study of public policy, policy analysis, and the policy-making process. Students in the minor study ideas from multiple disciplines and explore issues impacting today's world.

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### Science, Engineering, and Public Policy (SEPP)

The Science and Engineering in the Public Interest minor introduces students to the relationship between government and the science, engineering and innovation industry. The minor explores issues including national security, healthcare, transportation, energy and the environment.

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
